History AutoCAD Cracked Version evolved from MicroStation. Unlike MicroStation, which was primarily a package intended for design engineers, AutoCAD was designed to be a general-purpose CAD application, and it made far fewer claims of being a full-fledged CAD application than MicroStation. Early versions of AutoCAD used an

even more limited graphical user interface than MicroStation, but version 2.0 introduced a whole new GUI, known as "A-Frame". Controls The interface between a user and AutoCAD is provided by an application window.

The user's work area is the area occupied by the application window. Each application window is divided into two areas, an edit window for manipulating the drawing and a tool pallet for displaying and selecting various tools. The user can click a "drag" icon to select an existing tool from the tool pallet, or click the top-left icon to bring up the tool pallet, and then select an existing tool. New tools are

---

available in the tool pallet by clicking an icon with the text "NEW" in the bottom-right corner of the tool pallet. The user can drag tools from the tool pallet into the edit window. The top icon of a tool's drop zone can be clicked to set that tool in that area. The user can also double-click an existing tool to select it. The tool pallet. Click the top left icon to open a tool pallet. The top icon with the text "NEW" can be clicked to open a tool pallet with tools that can be dragged into the edit window. Clicking a tool in the tool pallet sets it in the edit window and display of that tool is turned on. Click the bottom-right icon to close the tool

---

pallet. Windows, AutoCAD allows the user to work on multiple drawings at the same time. You can open a second drawing, switch to it, and then return to the original drawing. A number of different tools are provided to complete various tasks. The most basic tools are Freehand tools. When a freehand tool is selected, a work area appears around the tool. The user can draw a line, arc, or ellipse within the work area. The drawing is automatically updated as the user draws. These drawing tools are often used to create simple shapes such as boxes, circles, and lines. The most advanced tools are solid modeling tools. When solid
